Q: The RFP calls for a contact at the LWIB and a fiscal contact. Does that mean the fiscal contact at the ADD or someone else?

A: See below regarding the role of the LWIB, they are to serve as the fiscal agent for grant funds. As long as the LWIB role is completed as specified below, it is fine to include the fiscal contact at the ADD too.

Q: What does it really mean when it says, "All applications must be submitted through the LWIB?" Does this mean the LWIB Director will sign off on it or does it involve more than that?

A: Here is what the RFP specifies regarding the role of the LWIB:

"To ensure collaboration and alignment with other regional initiatives, Local Workforce Investment Boards (LWIBs) must be represented in the Partnership. LWIBs will serve as the fiscal agent for grant funds and will work with the lead applicant in monitoring and compliance. Additionally, LWIBs will be required to follow their Board's approved contracting procedures."

Q: The RFP calls for 5 hard copies of the proposal as well as the electronic submission. Do the hard copies have to be in Frankfort by Friday afternoon or just the electronic version?

A: OK to mail hard copies with Friday postmark.
